

Low-carbon travel guidance

Goldsmiths has a longstanding international ethos, and we recognise the pivotal importance of our international networks, collaborations and activities.

However, we also know that we need to reduce the carbon intensity of our transport and travel. This is why we have committed to a 50% reduction in these emissions by 2025, against a 2018/19 baseline.

We are also exploring ways to reduce the carbon footprint of our business travel and have committed to choosing low-carbon travel options as the default option. Taking a flight is sometimes unavoidable, but in these cases, we will offset the carbon emissions associated with the air travel we have procured.

We also want to work with our partners to facilitate low-carbon travel options.
